According to Grice (1975), Cooperative Principle consists of four maxims. The maxims are maxim of quantity, the maxim of quality, maxim of relation, and maxim of manner. In this research, the researcher describes Grice's maxims used in the interview Prince Harry and Meghan, and the researcher found there are violations made by the speakers during the interview.

M : **Oh it would be a year and a half**, a little bit more than that?

PH: No just about it- it would be a year and a half yeah.

In the conversation above, the maxim was used maxim of quantity. And Prince Harry gives the information was enough to the interviewer, and it can be classified as the maxim of quantity. In the sentence "No just about it- it would be a year and a half yeah". It means, the Prince was given information of what he believes and not gives other information that does not relate to the question.

The answer the classification of kinds of Grice's Maxim that occurred in the conversation between Prince Harry and Meghan Markle includes four kinds, that is quantity, quality, relation, manner.
